




Pines of Perinton Construction updates December 1, 2023

- Interior renovations of first block of units on Evergreen and families have moved back into their renovated units. Residents in batch 2-3 (88 134
 Evergreen) have moved to hospitality units and work in their units is underway. Block 4 (54-86 Evergreen) will be moving to hospitalities first week
 of December. Housing to Homes is working with impacted households on moving logistics and schedule details and updates.
- Due to supply chain delays, new entry doors and windows will be installed later for most of Evergreen. We apologize for the inconvenience and will
 provide notice of dates of installs when materials arrive on site.
- Exterior painting is 100% completed, and aluminum metal flashing is completed and trim around the parameter is 50% completed.
- Due to decisions to expand scope of cabinet and closet work, residents should anticipate being out of their units for around 4 weeks during renovations
 to accommodate work, all move logistics, pest and environmental inspections and clearance, and final punch list walks and cleaning. Durations will
 vary based on season and unit size/type. Housing to Homes is coordinating with all households individually with details.
- The fire rebuild will be complete at the end of December.
- Please contact us with any feedback and/or questions if you see anything concerning in your newly renovated unit.
- Residents on Balsam will be doing their household assessment with Housing to Homes in the next few weeks. Please reach out to Luis at Housing to Homes to set up your assessment if you have not already. 585-252-4009.
- Work at the lower exterior 5 stairs is in process and concrete for ADA ramps will be poured in early December.
- The Leasing and Community buildings are currently under construction with scheduled completion in the New Year.
- New mailboxes will be installed soon and will adhere to new ADA guidelines where applicable.

Vehicle Safety Tips


- Make sure doors are locked and windows are up.
