Recipe of the Month

Easy Ice Cream Cake



Ingredients

- 1 cup heavy cream
- 2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar
- 6 ice cream sandwiches (3.5 ounces each)
- ½ cup chocolate chips, chopped

Directions

- 1. Line an 8½-by-4½-inch loaf pan with a piece of wax paper or parchment, allowing the paper to hang over both long sides.
- 2. In a large bowl, beat the cream and sugar until stiff peaks form.
- 3. In the bottom of the pan, arrange 3 of the sandwiches in a single layer, cutting them to fit as necessary. Spread with half the whipped cream. Repeat with the remaining sandwiches and whipped cream.
- 4. Sprinkle the top of the cake with the chopped chocolate chips. Cover with plastic wrap and freeze until firm, at least 1 hour and up to 1 week.
- 5. Holding both sides of the paper overhang, lift the cake out of the pan and transfer to a platter. Discard the paper and serve.

Vegan Chickpea-Nut Butter Ice Cream Cake



Ingredients

1 batch chickpea-nut butter ice cream2 oz (about 1/4 cup) unsweetened or dark chocolate, meltedCoconut chips or shredded coconut, for topping

Chocolate Crust

1 1/2 cup raw cashews

1/2 cup unsweetened shredded coconut

3 tablespoons cocoa powder

3 tablespoons margarine, butter or coconut oil, melted

Instructions

Make the crust: In a food processor or high-speed blender, process the cashews and coconut until it forms a coarse flour.

Add the cocoa powder and margarine to the food processor and process until the mixture sticks together when pressed. Add one tablespoon of water if needed.

Transfer the crust to an 8-inch cake pan with removable bottom (you can use any cake pan, although this will make it easier to cut and serve). Press the crust mixture evenly to the bottom of the pan.

Make the ice cream: In a high-speed blender (I use the same one used for the crust, no need to clean it), add all the ingredients for the chickpea ice cream and blend until smooth. (Get the recipe for the ice cream here).

Pour the ice cream mixture evenly over the crust. Place in the freezer overnight or for at least 8 hours until firm. When the cake has frozen, drizzle with chocolate and sprinkle with coconut. Let the chocolate harden in the freezer for 5-10 minutes. Serve and enjoy!

Monthly Construction Update - August 2023

Rehabilitation Project: Roof replacement work was completed on Locust and started on Evergreen. Exterior painting is underway. Specific vacant units are undergoing testing and abatement where required by law when significant demolition occurs inside a unit. The state has reviewed and approved the demolition and abatement contractor's plan and all contractors are proceeding as required per NY State and Federal health, safety, and environmental requirements.
